

## Nominating an Alumnus for the Award

### **Purpose**

To recognize the professional nursing achievement of an alumnus of the Cornell University-New York Hospital School of Nursing.

### **Objectives**

1. To identify graduates of the School of Nursing who have distinguished themselves in nursing.
2. To acquaint the public and the alumni with the achievements of the award recipient.

### **Criteria for Nomination**

1. The individual should have a record of achievement in one or more of the following fields in nursing:
  - \* Nursing Practice
  - \* Nursing Service
  - \* Nursing Education
  - \* Nursing Research
  - \* Teaching
2. Significant professional contributions should have been made in one or more of the following ways:
  - \* Publishing
  - \* Lecturing and program participation beyond that of the usual job requirements
  - \* Original research (this may be based on doctoral dissertation)
  - \* Clinical studies which have led to the improvement of patient care

### **Supporting Data**

1. Minimum of two letters of support—one from a non-alumnus, one from an alumnus.
2. Curriculum Vitae—updated within the past 12 months.
3. Sample of publications when available—no more than three need to be submitted.
